FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the major differences between a Mini-Skimmer T.S. and a Mini-Skimmer?

The Mini-Skimmer T.S. skims with a tube instead of a belt and can access sumps from the side. This sideways orientation is great for hard-to-reach sumps or sump that lack access from the top entirely. The tube slowly circulating through the liquid can also draw the oil toward it, where it is then skimmed from the surface. The T.S. offers customers the same industrial-grade performance as standard Mini-Skimmers with the added versatility of multiple mounting options.

What are some features of Mini-Skimmer T.S. that differ from its competition?

The T.S. was designed to be the most compact tube skimmer (3"x4-5/8"x4" without stand) on the market without giving up ruggedness or performance. We use the same permanent magnet synchronous motor that has made Mini-Skimmer the most reliable oil skimmer on the market since 1989. Another innovative product that is the result of Wayne Products' 30 years of oil skimming expertise, Mini-Skimmer T.S. has an anodized aluminum housing and uses all corrosion-resistant materials. Its base can be used as a stand or a mount – the T.S. was also designed to be versatile and easy to use. Mini-Skimmer T.S. collects a half-gallon of oil per hour with an oleophilic polyurethane tube. Like our standard belt skimmers, the T.S. is an industrial grade solution that can last upwards of a decade on even the dirtiest sump tanks.


How does Mini-Skimmer T.S. work?

Both tube and belt oil skimmers have a motor that rotates an oleophilic (sticks to oil) tube/belt into and out of an oily mixture. Mini-Skimmer™ T.S. rotates the tube through a tight-fitting ceramic washer, which wipes the tube clean and directs the oil to a trough, then into a waste receptacle.

What lengths of belts are available for Mini-Skimmer T.S.?

While we only have belts that *reach* 8" or 12" stocked for same day shipping, we can accommodate custom orders in a day or two, so just tell us your needs!

The <u>reach</u> is the distance from where the tube exits the skimmer to the bottom of the tube. Note that the stand is not included, so a Mini-Skimmer T.S. with an **8" reach tube on a stand will reach about **5-3/8**" below the stand.**



How much oil does the Mini-Skimmer T.S. pick up?

The Mini-Skimmer T.S. has a 30RPM motor that rotates a 3/16" circumference tube – good for picking up a half gallon of oil per hour, plenty for nearly all machining centers and small CNC equipment.

Where can customers purchase the Mini-Skimmer T.S.?

Where is the Mini-Skimmer T.S. manufactured?

What is the closest comparable unit to the Mini-Skimmer T.S.?

There are certainly other tube skimmers on the market, but none combine the T.S.' compact size and rugged design with such a low price point.

What is the expected sale price of the Mini-Skimmer R.S.?

The Mini-Skimmer T.S. with a tube that reaches 8" below the drive unit should have a list price of about \$400.
